DEADLINE for entries Fri 21st September 2007

All entries must be received for judging by Fri 21st Sept to Callam Mitchell, Student Activities Co-ord, UCSA.

- These will be viewed and assessed by the judges
- The Ed Wood Awards Ceremony will be held at the UCSA on the night of Thursday 4th October 2007 where the finalists will be screened.

About the competition

- Videos can be in the genre of your choice. Here are a few ideas. Splatter, SciFi, Soap, Doco, Arty Farty, Sitcom, Musical, Epic, Fantasy, Spoof, Animation, Scratch or mix and match.
- Our recently added category "**The Weekend Wonders**" will be running once again, and on Friday 15th September we'll give out conditions and elements that must be in your video entry. You'll need to present your finished video to us by 4pm, 20th September.

Conditions Of Entry

1. Some UCSA students need to be involved in your production
2. Length is to be kept to no more than 10 minutes
3. You supply us with a good VHS, video 8, or DVD master copy for judging and screening (otherwise you must provide playback equipment for screening)
4. Stick within the law.
5. The UCSA takes no responsibility for any injuries, damages or law suits arising out of contestant's videos and their making or viewing of.
6. Judges' decisions will be final and no disputes will be entered into.
7. The producer will give the UCSA limited screening and taping rights to their video. The master tape is the property of the producer and can be picked up by arrangement with the Student Activities Co-Ordinator.

Judging Criteria

Your video will be judged on things like entertainment value, originality, how well the plot or theme comes together and technical ability.

We cannot promise amazing prizes, so you should enter the competition more for the experience and the chance of winning an Edwina, which you get to keep!

Awards

Prizes will (probably) be awarded in the following categories for: Best Video, Most Popular Video, Best Director, Best Editor, Best Actor, Best Actress, Best Screenplay, Best Script Writer, Best Special Effects, Best Camera Operator, Best Weekend Wonder, Best Wardrobe, Spirit of Ed Wood, Best Animation, Best Use Of Models, Best Bad Ad, and others we might come up with that we haven't thought of yet.
